

Women's Discovery Trip to Rwanda

31th May to 9th June 2025 (10 days) or
31th May to 12th June 2025 (13 days incl. Akagera Nationalpark)



This small-group tour invites us to explore the incredible story of the women who rebuilt and redefined Rwanda after the 1994 genocide. With courage, entrepreneurial spirit, resilience, and hard work, they have shaped the "new" Rwanda. Together, we open doors to meaningful cultural and economic exchanges in what is often called the Switzerland of Africa.

- Day 8 Nyungwe National Park – Chimpanzee Trekking – Canopy Walk.
- Day 9 Woman Drummers – Nyanza, King's Palace – Kigali.
- Day 10 ***The 10 days tour ends and guests are transferred to the airport in the evening.***
13 days trip: Drive to Akagera National Park.
- Day 11 Full day game drive in Akagera National Park.
- Day 12 Safari - Behind the scenes of park management - Sunset Boat Trip.
- Day 13 Transfer to the airport and departure.

ITINERARY Women Discovery Trip

DAY 1: ARRIVAL

We arrive at Kigali International Airport, where we are warmly greeted by our tour leader. After a short transfer, we check in at Hotel Eagle View, renowned for its breathtaking views of Kigali. Dinner will be served at the hotel as we relax and enjoy the stunning cityscape.

DAY 2: FULL KIGALI CITY TOUR - KIGALI BY NIGHT

After breakfast at 8:00 am, we meet our guide and begin a full-day exploration of Kigali.

First stop: Nyamirambo Women Center (NWC). This inspiring NGO, founded in 2007 by 18 local women, works to combat gender-based violence, inequality and discrimination. Today, it provides vocational training and employment opportunities for women in need. We will learn about their product line "Umutima" ("heart" in Kinyarwanda), featuring handmade accessories, clothing and home decor items.



During the guided tour, we'll enjoy a traditional snack, a brief Kinyarwanda language lesson and an introduction to the Center's activities. The tour weaves through the vibrant Nyamirambo neighborhood, visiting places like a women's hairdressing salon (where the adventurous can get a braid), a local family's home to pound cassava leaves and a tailor shop to discover traditional fabrics.



Lunch: At the Republica restaurant, we will enjoy the delicious Rwandan cuisine.

Afternoon: We visit the **Kigali Genocide Museum**, a moving place of remembrance and education, honoring victims of the 1994 genocide and promoting reconciliation and peace.

Evening: Dinner in Nyamirambo offers a chance to experience Kigali by night, with its lively atmosphere and local flavors.

DAY 3: DIAN FOSSEY MUSEUM - VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK


After breakfast at 10:00 am, we travel to **Volcanoes National Park**, arriving in Kinigi Village.

Lunch: Upon arrival, we enjoy lunch and later visit the **Dian Fossey Museum**. The museum honors the life and work of Dian Fossey, a pioneering conservationist who devoted herself to studying and protecting mountain gorillas. Her legacy lives on through the Gorilla Fund's ongoing efforts in conservation, science and education.

Evening: We attend a presentation by the **Gorilla Doctors**, learning about their critical work in ensuring the health and survival of Rwanda's gorilla population.

DAY 4: FULL DAY LOCAL VILLAGE BIKING TOUR - CULTURAL EXPERIENCES

At 9:00 am, after breakfast, we embark on a **biking tour** through the twin lakes region and Burera village. The day will be filled with intercultural experiences, as we meet locals, explore the twin lakes' island and enjoy a traditional dance performance. Lunch will be served in the local community, offering a taste of authentic Rwandan hospitality.



Afternoon: We cycle back to the lodge to relax and refresh. A support vehicle will be nearby in case of emergencies.

DAY 5: GORILLA TREKKING - INSHUTI ART GALLERY

We start early with breakfast at 6:40 am, then drive to **Volcanoes National Park** to meet our trackers. After a safety briefing, we head out to track the mountain gorillas. The trek takes us through the lush, cultivated foothills of the Virungas and into the rainforest, home to a rich variety of wildlife, including buffalo, elephants, colorful birds and butterflies.



Upon encountering a gorilla family, we spend a magical hour observing these magnificent creatures in their natural habitat. Watching their daily routines - playing, feeding, resting, and caring for their young - creates unforgettable memories.

Afternoon: After lunch at the lodge, we visit the **Inshuti Art Gallery** and enjoy a traditional cultural dance performance by local children.

DAY 6: KINUNU – KIBUYE

After breakfast and check-out, we drive to Gisenyi and take a scenic boat ride to Kinunu for a **coffee processing experience**. Kinunu is known for its high-quality coffee, grown and processed locally. We will see every step of production, from harvesting the cherries to creating green coffee ready for export.

Lunch: Enjoy a meal at Kinunu before continuing our boat journey to Karongi.

DAY 7: SANGIRA - NYUNGWE NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy a relaxed morning. At approximately 11:00 am, we begin our scenic drive to Nyamasheke along Rwanda's most beautiful lakefront road. We stop for a light lunch at the **Sangira Hospitality School**, where we also tour the facility. Sangira, supported by the Swiss NGO *Sangira Friends of Rwanda*, provides vocational education to empower young individuals in Rwanda and piloting a Swiss Culinary Training program in the Nyamasheke District.

Afternoon: After our visit, we continue to hotel Marvilla, where we check in and spend the evening enjoying the tranquil surroundings by the lake.

DAY 8: CHIMPANZEE TREKKING – CANOPY WALK

After an early breakfast, we depart at 4:50 am for chimpanzee trekking in **Nyungwe National Park**. The drive to the starting point takes about an hour. Following a safety briefing from our park guide, we set off to search for chimpanzees in the lush forest. Along the way, we may also spot black-and-white colobus monkeys, vervet monkeys and other wildlife.



Afternoon: We return to the lodge for lunch, then head out at 1:30 pm for an exhilarating canopy walk. Suspended 50 meters above the forest, this walk offers breathtaking views of Nyungwe from above, as well as opportunities to spot birds and other wildlife.

DAY 9: WOMAN DRUMMERS - NYANZA - KING'S PALACE – KIGALI

After breakfast at 8:00 am, we begin our drive to Kigali, stopping first in Huye to visit the **Ingoma Nshya Women Drummers**. This inspiring group of 20 women defies cultural norms, as drumming was once reserved exclusively for men. We will spend two hours with the group, enjoying performances of drumming and traditional dance, and even learning to play the drums ourselves.



Afternoon: Our journey continues to Nyanza, where we visit the **King's Palace Museum**. This reconstructed traditional royal residence, shaped like a beehive, offers insight into Rwanda's royal history. We'll also meet the royal Inyambo cattle, known for their striking long horns and the songs sung to them by their keepers.



We arrive in Kigali in the late afternoon and check in at the Mille Collines Hotel, renowned for its historical significance. In the evening, we gather for a farewell dinner at the Ubumwe Grand Hotel, just across from Mille Collines.

DAY 10: DEPARTURE

OR...

DAY 10: AKAGERA NATIONAL PARK – NIGHT GAME DRIVE

After breakfast, we check out and drive to **Akagera National Park**, located near the Tanzanian border. The park covers 1,200 km² and is home to diverse ecosystems, including savannahs, wetlands and mountains. Upon arrival, we take a special behind-the-scenes tour of the park headquarters to learn about conservation projects and meet some of the team working to protect Rwanda's wildlife.

Afternoon: After lunch, we embark on a thrilling **night game drive** from 4:50 pm to 8:00 pm, offering a rare opportunity to see nocturnal wildlife.

DAY 11: FULL-DAY GAME DRIVE

Morning & Afternoon: We set off at 6:30 am for a **full-day game drive** with packed lunches. Akagera National Park offers stunning landscapes, from open savannahs to wetlands, and is home to an array of wildlife, including lions, elephants, rhinos, giraffes and more. Along the lakeshores, we may spot hippos, crocodiles and numerous bird species.

Evening: After an exciting day of wildlife viewing, we return to the lodge for dinner and a relaxing evening.

DAY 12: MORNING GAME DRIVE – SUNSET BOAT CRUISE

Morning: After breakfast, we head out for a short **game drive** in the southern sector of the park, offering another chance to spot wildlife in the early hours.

Afternoon: After lunch at the lodge, enjoy some leisure time to relax before we head to Lake Ihema at 3:50 pm for a magical **sunset boat cruise**. The cruise includes a visit to a small island known as a bird paradise. Along the way, we keep an eye out for hippos, crocodiles and other animals coming to the lakeshore as the sun sets.




